Request for Proposals

The Conference Committee invites you to submit a presentation proposal for the 2011 Annual Conference. Proposals should be based on experience, research and theory applicable to campus children's programs.

Session Formats

Workshop sessions will be one hour and thirty minutes in duration.

Submission of Proposals

All proposals must be submitted electronically in the format outlined and will be selected by a blind review process. Incomplete proposals will not be considered.

Deadline for submission: October 1, 2010

Presenters will be notified by October 21, 2010. Current NCCCC members are given first consideration. All presenters will be required to register for the conference. The **lead presenter** receives a \$50 credit towards the conference registration fee of \$150 for one day and \$460 for the full four day conference.

Proposal Format

Submit 1 email with the following two attachments:

(1) A COVER PAGE including:

- Presenter name(s) and position(s)
- Institution(s)
- Address(es) phone numbers(s) email(s)
- Brief biographical sketch(es)
- Indicate if you are a current NCCCC member

**NOTE: The RFP committee will not view your electronic cover page to ensure the blind review process, but the cover page is still required for documentation.*

(2) PRESENTATION PROPOSAL including:

- Identification of the track your proposal addresses
- Title of presentation
- A 25 word abstract to be included in the conference program
- Outline of the content and the method of presentation (lecture, discussion, etc.)
