### Purpose

The Child Care Access Means Parents in School Program supports the participation of low-income parents in the postsecondary education system through the provision of campus-based childcare services. The Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, authorizes the Secretary of Education to award grants to institutions of higher education to assist the institution in providing campus-based child care services to low-income students.

Eligible activities include, but are not limited to:

- Supporting or establishing a campus-based child care program primarily serving the needs of low-income students enrolled at the institution.
- Establishing or expanding childcare programs for infants and toddlers as well as providing before and after school services for older children to the extent necessary to enable low-income students enrolled at the institution of higher education to pursue postsecondary education.
- Subsidizing the costs of the childcare services for your low-income students.
- Programs involving parents.
- Faculty, staff, program, and curriculum development.
- Travel for professionals.
- Supplies and equipment.
- Costs for personnel.
- Minor renovations and repairs.

### Eligibility

**Who May Apply:** Institutions of Higher Education

An institution of higher education is eligible to receive a grant under this program if the total amount of all Federal Pell grant funds awarded to students enrolled at the institution of higher education for the preceding fiscal year equals or exceeds \$350,000.

**Participant Eligibility:** Low-income parents who are eligible to receive a Federal Pell grant.
